## **BEING A VOLUNTEER**

Volunteers are an integral part of the work Hope Hospice & Palliative Care Rhode Island does in bringing comfort and support to people nearing the end of life and to their families.

Our caring volunteers come from all walks of life and have many different interests and talents. They are special people who share the common bond of making a difference in the quality of others' lives through direct patient care, grief support to bereaved families, community outreach, special events, fundraising, office support and complementary therapies.

The work we do helps thousands of Rhode Island families every year as they cope with end-of-life issues. The contributions of our volunteers are immeasurable.

By being a hospice volunteer, you can gain great personal satisfaction from knowing you have made an impact in another person's life. Many volunteers feel honored to have the opportunity to be present with an individual at such a poignant and vulnerable time. More than 300 volunteers currently share their time and talents in meaningful ways at Hope Hospice & Palliative Care Rhode Island. What they have in common is their desire to help people in end-of-life care.

At Hope Hospice & Palliative Care Rhode Island, you decide which volunteer role is the best match for your talents, skills and availability. We provide specialized training for whatever role you choose to be sure you are comfortable with your responsibilities before you begin. In addition, we are readily available to address volunteers' questions and concerns any time.

## PATIENT AND FAMILY SUPPORT

Volunteers provide critical support to patients and families. Hope Hospice & Palliative Care Rhode Island volunteers visit patients in their homes, nursing homes, hospitals and the Philip Hulitar Hospice Center. In this role, volunteers may:

- Read to, play cards with or just talk with a patient
- Provide transportation
- Shop or do errands
- Give the family time to rest and relax
- Call or visit grieving family members
- Pray with patients and family members
- Provide comfort during a vigil as a patient nears death



## **COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

Volunteers who choose to assist Hope Hospice & Palliative Care Rhode Island with its work in the community may:

- Work on special events
- Join our fundraising team
- Provide information about hospice at health fairs
- Work with the speakers' bureau
