Both of Andrea Hazian’s parents were cared for by the expert team in the HopeHealth Hulitar Center. The experience was profound: “It was like somebody was holding your hand the entire time,” she said. But she remembered one hospice aide in particular: Patrick Wallace, CNA, CHPNA. When she saw a post on Facebook about HopeHealth’s Spirit of Hope Award, she couldn’t help commenting: “Patrick made my Mom LAUGH! He is such a special man. Thank you for all you do and for the loving care you gave to my Mom.”

Patrick Wallace (pictured below), is the first ever recipient of the Spirit of Hope Award, which was created in 2023 to recognize HopeHealth’s skilled hospice aides. Wallace was voted by his peers to receive the honor. “He is genuine in his delivery of care. He is a listening ear for families as they tell the story of their loved one. He is a very special human. In fact, he is known among our staff as “Saint Patrick,” said Breda Hines, RN, CHPN, Manager of the Hulitar Hospice Center. “Need I say more!”

Wallace was recognized at An Evening of Hope & Gratitude, HopeHealth’s gala fundraiser, on June 8, 2023, along with

U.S. Senator Sheldon Whitehouse and Drs. Terrie Fox Wetle and Richard Besdine (pictured below). In his remarks, Wallace recognized his colleagues, several of whom were present to cheer him on. “I want you all to know that we as a team love what we do and deeply care about all the patients and families that come through the doors of HopeHealth,” said Wallace.

The work of hospice aides is sometimes overlooked but is critical to patient—and family—care. “Patrick brings with him, every day, his vast knowledge of hospice, his gentle spirituality, and his boundless energy,” said Virginia Magnan, RN, CHPN, Director, Hulitar Hospice Center. “Somehow, in the darkest moments, Patrick will manage to elicit laughter from patients and family members.... He’s one in a million.”

“My Mom and Patrick had an ongoing joke,” said Hazian. “I don’t know what it was, but I knew she was surrounded by loving care. He made her last days better. He made our days better.”

Meaningful Giving through a QCD

An expert on health care leadership and governance and the author of a book on cancer caregivers, Deborah J. Cornwall brings a unique perspective to her service on HopeHealth's Board of Directors. "Everyone on the HopeHealth team is so committed to the organization, our patients, and to each other—they inspire the Board," she said. "They see multiple dimensions of every patient and every caregiver and they focus on doing whatever they can to enrich people's lives for as much time as they have left."

Cornwall and her husband recently learned about an opportunity to support HopeHealth more generously than they had thought possible—and to save on taxes, too. "Our 401K had done well and our required minimum distribution was larger than we had expected – but so were the tax implications," Cornwall said. Their financial planner suggested a Qualified Charitable Distribution: a way to make a tax-free gift from their retirement plan directly to their favorite charities. "We identified two organizations we wanted to support in a major way – of course, one was HopeHealth Hospice & Palliative Care," said Cornwall. "We are living on a fixed income, so this was our opportunity to do that and still eat!"

Even more meaningful was that the Cornwalls could designate their support to a specific HopeHealth program: Advanced Illness Care. "Being able to direct our support has really strengthened my connection to HopeHealth. It is an incredible feeling to know that we are part of caring for HopeHealth's patients and everyone impacted by their illnesses," said Cornwall.

The Champlin Foundation Makes a Difference in South County

The white clapboard colonial at Number 143 on Wakefield, RI's busy Main Street has been the face of HopeHealth in South County since 2008. Housing 55 employees on two hospice teams who serve more than 225 patients each day in their homes and in long-term care facilities, this is a busy place. Hospice interdisciplinary teams meet here, nurses and aides pop in to get assignments and pick up supplies, social workers and grief counselors meet with families, and patient care managers juggle everything to ensure patients get the very best care.

Over the years, this heavy use wore down the building's once elegant façade. The interior was shabby, with rooms that were subdivided into office spaces in the 1970s. Heating and electrical systems were outdated. "HopeHealth needed to make an investment in this building," said Jennifer Rogers, RN, CHPN, Patient Care Manager for the South Home Team, "so that it would continue to support the important work of our hospice teams – and be a professional and welcoming environment for our staff."

The Champlin Foundation stepped in with a generous grant of \$133,500 to support interior and exterior renovations to the building. Rogers participated in the site visit with representatives from the Foundation and was impressed by their longtime commitment to HopeHealth's patients—and their interest in the behind-the-scenes work the building represents. "The Champlin Foundation folks could appreciate that the building is part of the care that we offer our families. My staff's ability to work efficiently in clean, safe, professional surroundings is all part of the hope that we give our families. The renovations have made such a difference!"

A New Role: Hospice Volunteer

A veteran actor with numerous film, television and theatre credits, Richard Donelly found that becoming a hospice volunteer caused a bit of stage fright, at first.

"The first time I walked into a patient's room [at the Hulitar Hospice Center], I was nervous," said Donelly. "I didn't want to say the wrong thing or make them feel like they *had* to talk with me."

But people *are* willing to talk with Donelly and share a range of emotions from humor to sorrow. One patient offered that he was curious to know where he would go after he died. "We joked that if he could, he should find a way to let me know, because I was curious too," laughed Donelly.

Another afternoon, a patient's mother asked Donelly to talk over a cup of coffee. "She said that losing her son was the worst thing she had ever experienced," said Donelly. "I am humbled that she saw me as someone she could open up to."

Donelly has plenty of life experience to bring to this new role: both parents were supported by a hospice in Florida. As he sees it, volunteering is another way to connect. "I've been an actor my entire life, but it's in my nature to want to help people," he said. When dear friend Stefani Hulitar (the Hulitar Hospice Center was named for her father) suggested he might consider volunteering, it seemed like a natural fit.

As one of HopeHealth's 223 volunteers, Donelly's part in patient care is vital. "I know I am helping them in that moment," he said. "And it is the moment-to-moment that gets our families through this experience of loss and grief."

Alzheimer's Disease Assistance Program Offers Caregiver Support



Since 2001, HopeHealth Community VNA's Alzheimer's Disease Assistance Program has provided respite care, caregiver support groups, education programs, and resources to caregivers of people with dementia in the Attleboro, MA region. This free program, supported by philanthropic gifts and grants, offers caregivers an opportunity to refresh and recharge themselves and gain support and advice from Program Coordinator Robin Walsh, LSW.

In the last year, with support from the Fred M. Roddy Foundation, Lloyd G. Balfour Foundation, Sophia Romero Trust, Bluestone Bank Charitable Foundation and other community donors, the program has grown exponentially, offering increased respite hours at an adult day center or in the home, gathering caregivers in eight different support groups—and seeing a 37% increase in patients enrolled.

Ed Ellis was diagnosed with vascular dementia four years ago and his wife, Peg, has cared for him at home. "I'm not sure which has been more helpful," said Peg, "the time at an adult daycare center, HopeHealth's educational series, or my weekly support group." Best of all, Peg can call on Walsh or her support group facilitators, Jamie and Mark, with a question whenever she needs help. "They understand the frustration and grieving that is part of our lives now—Jamie and Mark have lived through it—and it means so much to me to know that I can get support when I need it."

Setting the Standard for Advanced Illness Care

Patients with serious illnesses like cancer, heart failure or COPD often face a bewildering and fragmented medical system. The new Advanced Illness Care program at HopeHealth Hospice & Palliative Care brings palliative nurse practitioners into the home to coordinate patients' care needs with their goals of care, help manage symptoms, and support families in making informed healthcare decisions. "Our goal," said Program Manager, Kaitlin Collins, NP, ACHPN, "is that our patients stay out of the hospital and safe and comfortable in their own homes for as long as possible."

HopeHealth launched Advanced Illness Care in March 2023 with just 32 patients. Today, there are more than 200 patients supported by the team. "Patients learn about us through their current provider or a HopeHealth palliative team member at the hospital," said Maria Appenfeller, RN, CHPN, Advanced Illness Care Transitions Manager. "So, we start working with our patients immediately from a place of trust."

That trusted reputation means that foundations and donors are willing to invest in the intensive program. The Edward R. and Virginia M. Routhier Foundation, the Rhode Island Foundation and several individual donors have already supported Advanced Illness Care. "I hope it will be there for me when my time comes," said donor Barbara Ruttenberg.

"HopeHealth has set the standard for palliative care for more than two decades," said Collins. "With Advanced Illness Care, we are giving our patients and their families the hope to live their best quality of life for as long as they can."

It Never Rains on the HopeHealth Invitational!

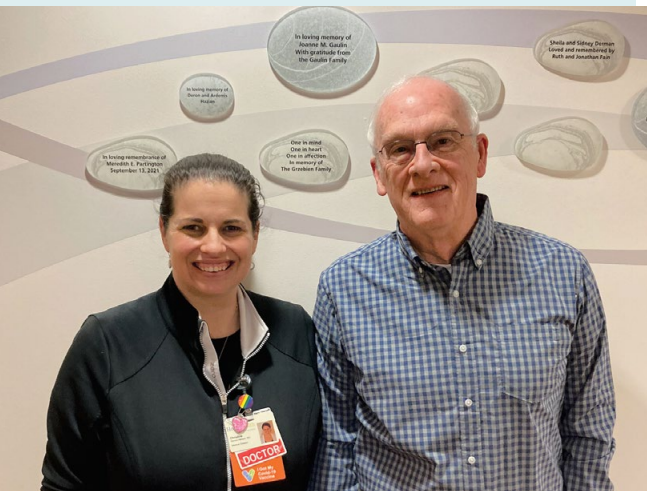

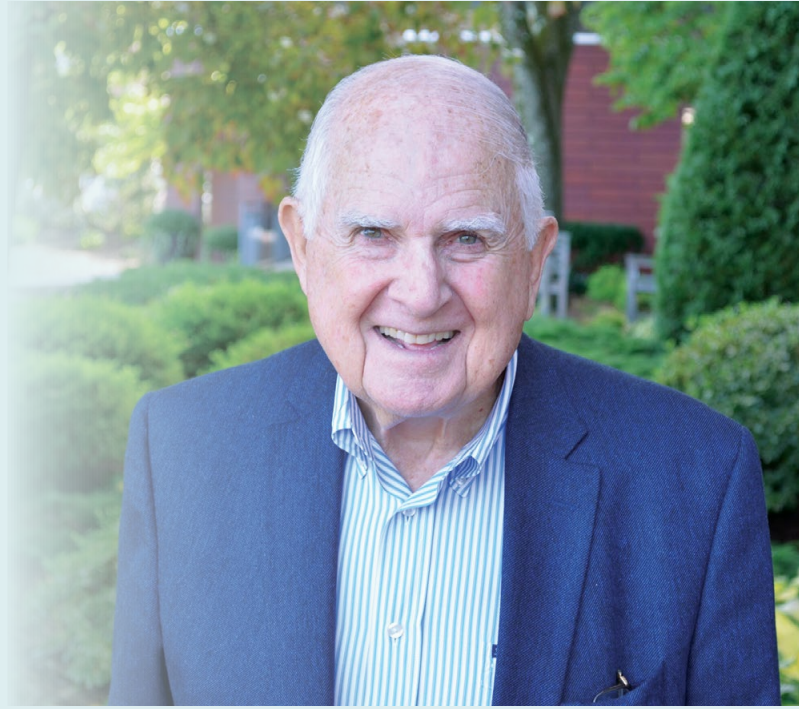
Arthur Robbins' Legacy

Arthur Robbins, a person many think of as “Mr. Rhode Island,” passed away on February 20, 2024. Arthur believed that our highest calling is to treat one another with dignity. From the moment he joined HopeHealth’s board of directors in the mid-1970s, he fought to give patients at the end of life just that.

At the time, the world did not yet understand or appreciate hospice the way that Arthur did. This didn’t intimidate him—it motivated him. He dreamed big. He set his sights on building Rhode Island’s only freestanding inpatient hospice facility.

As a result of Arthur’s advocacy and fundraising, the Hular Hospice Center exists today. Every day, patients and families tell us about the comfort, peace and dignity they find here, a place where they spend precious final moments together.

Arthur Robbins, HopeHealth’s chair emeritus, made that possible. He is a reminder to all of us that one person can make a profound difference for many. In the work of hospice, we often remind patients and families that even when a person’s life comes to an end, their legacy has just begun. Arthur’s legacy lives on in all of us at HopeHealth, and the work we are privileged to do.

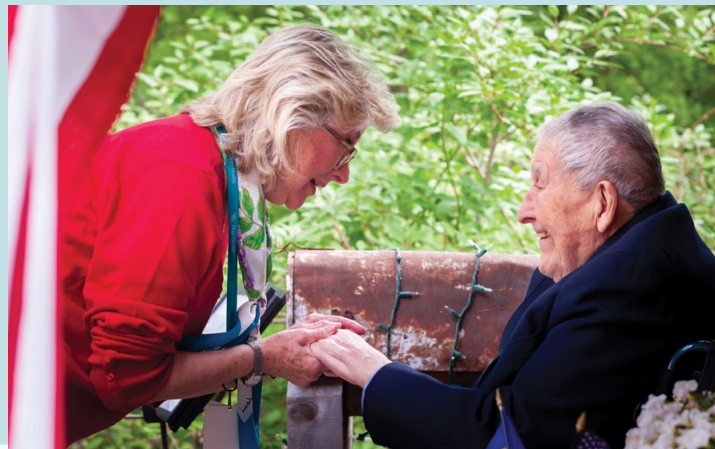

In a recent survey of HopeHealth’s donors, “we learned some interesting information,” said Suzanne Fortier, Chief Philanthropy Officer. “We were surprised and pleased to find that 50% of our donors said that they were motivated to give to HopeHealth because they know an employee. This suggests a very strong sense of connection to the organization,” she continued. In fact, many respondents shared stories of care their loved ones received.

HopeHealth’s donors tend to be slightly older than the average of all U.S. donors, which is age 65. Knowing this information helps HopeHealth communicate with our donors better.
