Pediatric Palliative Care

Palliative care is comprehensive treatment of the discomfort, symptoms and stress of serious illness. It is a key part of care for children living with life-limiting illness and an important source of support for their families. The goal of the HopeHealth PediPal program is to improve quality of life for the entire family through its support and services.



Services are provided in-home, but virtual options are available if needed.

- Case management
- Nursing and social work assessment
- Skilled pain and symptom management
- Psychosocial support for the child, siblings, and family
- Spiritual care
- Respite reimbursement
- Complementary therapies including, Music and Massage Therapy, Reiki, Dance & Movement, DIR Floortime, Art, and Pet Therapy
- Child life specialists
- Advance care planning
- IEP support
- Bereavement care for the family

Music Therapy

Eligibility

All children who live in Massachusetts determined by a physician to have a potentially life-limiting illness are eligible for the program. There are no restrictions on the life expectancy of the child, and children enrolled in PediPal may continue with curative care. Children are admitted to the program without regard to gender identity, race, ethnicity, language, sexual orientation or ability to pay.
