Caregiver Support Groups

Taking care of yourself is one of the most important things you can do as a caregiver. We host a range of caregiver support groups, including groups focused on dementia, Parkinson's disease, and caring for veterans. Most are available virtually. All are free and open to the public.

Grief Support Services

The Center for Hope & Healing at HopeHealth offers individual and family counseling to families who have had a loved one under our care. We also host grief support groups, most held virtually, that are free and open to anyone in Rhode Island or Massachusetts who has experienced a loss within the last two years. Camp BraveHeart, our youth summer camp, helps children in the community work through their grief.

Hospice is dedicated care for patients who are in the advanced stages of serious illness or nearing the end of life. It is available for all ages, from infants through adults.

This type of care focuses on comfort, rather than cure — helping patients live as comfortably and fully as possible. We provide 24/7 support for managing pain and other symptoms. We also offer emotional and spiritual care for both patients and loved ones, supporting quality of life for the entire family.
